

SOLVED - Unable to start Server - Galaxy S4 Sprint Andoid 4.4.2

I have the Android App Controller giving me a success message that the "Server is running" but the App on the phone still says "Server is stopped" and I cannot connect (using Ultra VNC viewer).

I have tried the following:

- Rebooting the PC and the phone
- Using both MTP and PTP USB modes
- Connecting with USB mode through the VNC view and a browser

I have searched the forums and found the thread about this problem being solved on an S4 with a different version of Android, but it contained nothing that helped me.

It works fine with S4 1.4.4., you need to run some manual commands for now, before we upgrade our Android PC Controller.

```
cd "C:\Program Files (x86)\VMLiteAndroidAppController"  
adb shell  
cd /data/local/tmp  
cp /data/data/com.vmlite.vncserver/files/vmlitevncserver .  
./vmlitevncserver
```
