I don't know how you got the expression that our app does not support WIFI. Remote control android devices is the whole purpose of our vnc server. So, yes, it works flawlessly from WIFI, and you don't need to connect your device to the PC to remote control it.

The reason you still need a PC, is you need to start the vnc server once from PC, then you can disconnect the device, and use wifi to control the device.

Hi and thank you for the answer.

I didn't say that VMLite VNC doesn't work with WiFi, I'm just saying that I don't know how to make it work. I connect my phone (Android 4.0.4) to PC via USB, press "Start Service", it finds my phone, when on my phone I press start and I see that I get an IP address under the "Browser", for example: <http://192.168.2.1:5801> . I write this address in my browser address bar but when nothing happens. It is loading about 30 seconds and didn't open anything. I just don't know that I'm doing wrong. With USB everything works fine (writing with localhost).
