

Android App has no settings button

Hi. Just bought and downloaded the VMLite VNC Server app from the Google Play store. Installed it on a Samsung Galaxy Tab Pro 10.1 Tablet. It's running Kit Kit 4.4.2 and has been rooted.

Initial tests work great being able to connect with VNC. It's very responsive and seems to work well. But the one problem I noticed is that there is no Settings button within the app. This tablet does not have a physical settings button, so it needs to have a soft button built into the app to manage the VMLite VNC Server settings. When connected via VNC, the virtual button for settings work fine to get into the app's settings, but that's the only way to control the settings when using VNC.

Can we get a Settings button built into the app for these devices that do not have a physical button?

Otherwise, press F2 key from vnc viewer, F2 sends android Menu key to device.
